

PROHIBITED PLACES FOR SMOKING

COVERAGE

- All public transport, government-owned vehicles and other means of public transport within the territorial jurisdiction of Davao City;
- All accommodation and entertainment establishments;
- All workplaces;
- All enclosed public places;
- All partially enclosed public places;
- All public buildings;
- All public outdoor spaces.



Prohibited Products

Prohibited Products

Tobacco Products:

- * Any product that consists of loose tobacco that contains nicotine and is intended for use in a cigarette, including any product containing tobacco and intended smoking or oral or nasal use
 - Cigarettes
 - Shisha or Waterpipe

• Electronic Device Systems:

- * refer to any device such as electronic nicotine device systems, electronic cigarette and similar devices, whether or not it is used to deliver nicotine to the user, that resembles the outward appearance of real smoking products
 - E-cigarettes




